Rabin Ch. O. Grodzienski WILNO Poland Regno. Gaon Yisrael Shlit"a! Please forgive me for the delay in my response. Regarding the Torah Fund: I must tell the esteemed Rabbi Shlit"a that primarily I understood that my opinion is that the concentration is not correct, but I agreed at the time to the concentration of the Sephardim. The propaganda here for the concentration was that the Mizrachim wanted to acquire influence for themselves, therefore I agreed at that time to the concentration, but now my opinion is, and I have revealed it at the Torah Fund conference here, that it is time to abolish the concentration because now if we abolish it, we can be sure that it will not rise again, but they have insisted on me. My colleagues are waiting for 6 more moments. And since at first I did not want to participate in the work and in the committee, therefore the complaint is not on me, but I spoke with Perl and the young one and complained that he did not provide the esteemed Rabbi Shlit"a with the amount, and he replied to me that as he was told: 19 we have already sent 200 francs.
